This is an examination of Eastern Philosophies, most especially Daoism, and its parallels within the Craft.


Presenter: Friend, Worshipful Jacob Bressman



Minutes of August 2, 2020

A meeting of the Maryland Masonic Research Society was called to order at 3:00 p.m. on ZOOM by President Walter Benesch.

The attendance totaled 21 Zoom Participants

A panel discussion explored, ***Freemasonry During a Pandemic and the use of VR Meetings***. The presentation began with a brief introduction of panelists: Charles Stuppard, Jason Richards and Samantha Finstad. A summary that explored attitudes and misconceptions of the use of video conferencing platforms. The open discussion focused on what is being done to maintain activity while actual in lodge meetings were canceled. Even though many lodges were silent, there have been both open and tiled Masonic meetings using video conferencing within the lodges, the DC Scottish Rite, and several of the other appendant bodies of Masonry. A lively yet informative discussion followed with Q&A. President Walter Benesch gave his appreciation to the Panelists and Special Guests.
